THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

Attire

- Proper show attire is required for all classes. Collared shirt required for jumpers.
- Helmets must be worn while mounted. **The USEF requires all riders to wear USEF approved head gear.**

Classes

- Show will be conducted under NIHJA and USEF rules.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if necessary.
- Horses shown in classes not entered or entered at the gate will be charged a \$15 penalty fee in addition to the regular class fee.
- Trophy and six ribbons awarded in each class. Championship and reserve awarded in all divisions. You must be entered in the entire division to be eligible for championship and reserve points.
- Exhibitors are expected to be prompt for their classes. Multiple rides will be given consideration. **A one minute call will be placed on an open gate.**
- In order to add or scratch classes, **an official add/scratch form** must be filled out and **delivered to the show secretary's office.**
- Please observe the dotted line on course when making courtesy circles.

Stalls

- Stalls are permanent 10' x 12' or vinyl 10' x 10' with doors. Because of the cost of manure removal, first bedding is **not** included. Shavings must be purchased from horse show management at \$9 per compressed bale.
- Stalls will be available after Noon on Thursday.
- All stalls cancelled after 9 a.m. on Monday before the show will be charged to trainers.

Schooling

- Thursday noon to 7 p.m.
- Friday and Saturday to 1 hour before start time. No schooling in Ring Sunday.
- A warm-up area is available during the show. In addition, a warm-up class will remain open all day. Fence heights will change as show progresses through each day.

Miscellaneous

- **No smoking** in or near any building!
- A charge of \$50 will be made for returned checks.
- All dogs must be on a leash. Please leave dogs at home if possible.
- Current, negative coggins & proof of flu/rhino vaccine required with all entries.

The Hunter Derby will follow all rules of the USHJA National Hunter Derby except fence heights and prize money will be modified as shown below (for complete class specifications, see USEF rule HU192 and go to <https://ushja.org/programs/nhd/documents/NationalHunterDerbySpecs.pdf> Fence height 2'6" with option fences in the course set at 2'9".

- \$1,500 Prize Money will be distributed as follows: \$450 for 1st, \$330 for 2nd, \$225 for 3rd, \$150 for 4th, \$105 for 5th, \$90 for 6th, \$75 for 7th, \$75 for 8th.
- Formal Attire (per USEF rule HU128.3): riders are required to wear scarlet or dark coats; white shirts with white stock; white, buff or canary breeches and protective headgear. Shad belly encouraged but not required.
- The top 12 entries will return for a Second Round. The final score from each round will be added together for the total overall score.
- The Derby is open to all riders who are entered to compete in at least two other classes at this show. There is no limit to the number of horses a rider can ride in the Derby.
- Monogrammed: cooler 1st place, saddle pad 2nd place and baby pad 3rd place *provided by: www.HorseandPonyTack.com*. Large ribbons 1st through 8th place.
