10'x12' permanent stalls with doors available to first paid. Other stalls are 10'x10' temporary with doors. All horses must have a stall as we can no longer accommodate riders showing out of their trailers.

In order to prepare a time schedule with approximate start times for each class, **EVERYONE** must get their entries in by **Monday, May 14, 2018** or be subject to a **\$25 post entry fee** and **no time schedule!**

Stalls cancelled after the closing date will be charged to trainers.

PRIZES AT EVERY SHOW!

Trophy and six ribbons per class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each division with at least 3 riders in the first over fences class. To be eligible for champion and reserve, you must be entered in the entire division.

SOMETHING NEW.....

Two ground pole classes have been added to the Introductory Equitation Division which is for riders who are not yet comfortable cantering in a group. Riders entered in this Division are **not eligible for other classes**. Division consists of 1 walk, trot class; 1 class with walk, trot and individual canter (riders, one at a time, canter once around the arena in whatever direction they choose); and 2 classes over ground poles. Riders may trot or canter the ground poles and will "jump" **once** around the outside lines (so over 4 poles split into 2 lines). Simple changes of lead are allowed.

YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS

Riders who accumulate the most points in each division throughout Fields & Fences' and Cross Winds Farm's six summer shows will win gigantic ribbons not just for Champion and Reserve but **through 6th place!**

Year End Champions of **ALL** divisions will win \$150 cash and a perpetual trophy! Must be entered in the entire division to accrue year end points.

Points will be accumulated at each show based on **THE RIDER'S** ribbon awards received in corresponding classes throughout the six summer shows of the series. Professionals are not eligible for High Point Awards. Leading Trainer will be awarded based on the trainer with the most first place winners. Standings will be posted on the PTS series' web site, www.PTSshows.com, in each prize list and at www.FieldsandFences.com. Prizes will be awarded at the 9th annual PTS Ribbon Ball in November!

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

Attire

- All riders are required to wear USEF approved head gear while mounted.
- Proper show attire is required for all classes (except leadline).
- Mane braiding is optional.

Classes

- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if necessary.
- Exhibitors are expected to be prompt for their classes. Multiple rides will be given consideration. **A one minute call will be placed on an open gate.**
- Please observe the dotted line on course when making courtesy circles.
- **In order to add or scratch classes, an official add/scratch form must be filled out and delivered to the show secretary's office.**
- Horses shown in classes not entered or entered at the gate will be charged a \$15 penalty fee in addition to the regular class fee.

Stalls

- Stalls will be available after 2 p.m. on Saturday.
- Permanent stalls 10'x12' are limited and available on a first come first serve basis by **checks received**. Other stalls are 10'x10' temporary stalls with doors. Shavings are \$9 per bale. Please call in shavings order with stall count. Because of the cost of manure removal, do not bring your own shavings or straw.

Schooling

- The show arena will be open for schooling on Saturday from 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. and on Sunday morning until 7 am. Short/Long Stirrup schooling at 7:40 a.m.
- Sand warm-up arena with fences available day of show. In addition, a warm-up class will remain open all day. Fence heights will change as show progresses.

Miscellaneous

- **No smoking** in or near any building!
- Food available at show grounds.
- A charge of \$50 will be made for returned checks.
- All dogs must be on a leash. Please leave dogs at home if possible.
- Show starts at 8 a.m. sharp.
- **Negative Coggins & Flu/Rhino vaccination within 6 months required.**
